Mon 3:15 Dolores (2017) G In the 1950's a working-class wife and mother of eleven helps establish a union, which later develops beyond workers rights into a platform for feminism, gender equality and human rights. Documentary. 1 hr 35 minutes

Mon 9:15 Get Out (2017) R
A young African American photographer is nervous at the thought of meeting his European American girlfriend's parents at the parent's country estate. His anxiety soon turns to terror when he discovers the family hides an unsuspected conspiracy. 1 hr 43 minutes

Tues 3:15 Quakers- the Quiet Revolutionaries (2018) Award-winning documentary producer, director and writer Janet Gardner's engaging and powerful new documentary showing Quakers engaging in social action and justice out of our religious beliefs. The director will be here for conversation following the film. Documentary 1 hr. 27 min.

Tues 9:15 Call Me by Your Name (2017) R
A seventeen year old boy in 1980s Italy falls in love with a visiting American scholar hired as a research assistant for his father. Over the course of a memorable summer the two flirt as the teen discovers his sexuality. 2hrs 10 min.

Wed 9:15 Marshall (2017) PG-13 this historical drama set in 1940s Connecticut, depicts the early career

of NAACP lawyer, Thurgood Marshall, who would go on to become the first African-American Supreme court justice. 1hr. 58 mins

Thur 3:15 I Kill Giants (2017) PG A 12 year old girl enters the imaginary world of fantasy and magic where she is a skilled giant killer, possibly to escape troubling realities at home. Though largely misunderstood by her parents, classmates, and teachers, will newcomer, Sofia, be able to befriend her? Animated 1 hr 46 min.

Thur 9:15 Abacus: Small Enough to Jail (2016) During the mortgage crisis and financial collapse of 2008 only one financial institution was criminally indicted by the US government, a small Asian Savings and Loan in New York City. Documentary 1hr. 48 min.

Fri 3:15 Ferdinand (2017) PG Destined to become a fearless fighting bull, the young pacifist and flower-loving calf, Ferdinand, summons up the courage to escape from a Spanish bull-training camp, to finally find himself on little Nina's idyllic and fragrant farm. Animated 1 hr. 48 min.

Fri 9:15 Victoria and Abdul (2017) PG-13
Abdul Karim arrives from India to participate in Queen Victoria's golden jubilee. The young clerk is surprised to find favor with the queen herself. As Victoria questions the constrictions of her long-held position, the two forge an unlikely and devoted alliance that her household and inner circle try to destroy. 1 hrs 51 minutes.
